A rung spacing of 6 to 9 inches (150 to 230 mm) is preferable when the cable tray is used for instrumentation and control applications that require. The bends, tees, crosses, risers and reducers of wire mesh cable tray can be easily and quickly made live at the project by using a bolt cutter. Since the jaws of the bolt cutter drags a layer of zinc across the cut end and forms a protective layer. It is designed for. Cable sag results from incorrect spacing of cable tray supports or from employing the incorrect tray type that is, light-duty perforated trays in high-load applications.
