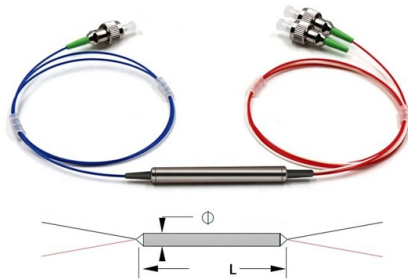


Function of disc spring in busbar connector

Disc springs are conical washers that can be loaded along their axis either statically or dynamically. This part contains the theoretical basis for the calculation and design of disc springs.
