

Parameters of stranded power optical cable



Overview

Stranding multiple stainless-steel tubes delivers 96–144F with robust tensile performance for long spans and heavy icing zones. The most overlooked parameter is Short-Circuit Energy, often expressed as $\text{kA}^2 \cdot \text{s}$. In this paper, the optimal fiber length in optical ground wire (OPGW) cable during production process is determined. The results show that in OPGW cable, if the fiber strand-ing length is less than the maximum lay length, the ultimate tensile stress (UTS) percent-age decreases, but if it is. Unlike standard fiber cables, OPGW (Optical Ground Wire) is not a commodity. It is a shield wire that must survive two enemies at the same time: Mechanical Stress (ice/wind) and Electrical Heat (short-circuit & lightning).
