

Repeated grounding of distribution box and switch box



Overview

Attach a ground wire from one of the threaded studs (A) at the bottom of the housing, to the mounting plate (B). The ground resistance between all system parts shall be $< 1 \Omega$. Grounding is a mechanism to protect distribution equipment and people under normal operating conditions, abnormal operational (overcurrent and overvoltage) responses, and hazardous conditions such as shocks. This helps to reduce the potential difference that exists between conductive parts and the earth. Knowledge of the various types of system grounding and performance characteristics is critical when designing or operating an electrical system. Each DISTRIBUTION BOX and controller must be grounded. 26 mm² (10 AWG) ground wire must be used, and in all other markets a 6 mm² must be used.
