The vertical distance between the bottom surface of fixed distribution box and switch box and the ground shall be greater than 1.6m. Wall penetrations require double sealing with flameproof putty and compression glands: Fundamental Principle : Your safest distribution box is the one that's not in the hazardous area at all.
