

What does SR4 on an optical module represent

400G SR4 transceivers are optical modules designed to support 400 gigabits per second (Gbps) data rates over short distances. The “SR” stands for “Short Reach,” and the “4” denotes that the transceiver uses four optical channels, each capable of transmitting 100 Gbps. Quick summary: SR4 modules are short-reach, multimode solutions that use MPO/MTP ribbon connections and are optimized for cost-effective, dense data-center fabrics over OM3/OM4 MMF; DR4 modules are data-center reach, single-mode solutions (or single-mode MPO variants) that extend reach.
